COUNTY COMMITTEE REGULATIONS

1. Title

GBA County Committee

2. Appointment

The Committee will consist of the Island Manager, as Chairman, and up to three other members elected at the GBA AGM. There should be a minimum of three members to include the Island Manager. There should be at least one member of each sex.

3. Reporting

- (a) Directly to the GBA Executive Committee as appropriate and as required.
- (b) Liaison with the GBA Development Officer on all matters for good communication.
- (c) Details of income and expenses must be provided to the GBA Treasurer or Financial Administration Assistant on a monthly basis as appropriate.

4. Conduct

The Committee members must apply a fair and equitable policy in their decisions to invite players into squad training sessions, and in any team selection process.

5. Responsibility

- a) Apply the Selection Criteria applicable to the County, Island Games and Commonwealth Games. See separate criteria as approved by the GBA Executive Committee dated 23 August 2005.
- b) For all funding of the Committees activities. See funding below.
- c) All decision making in relation to the County, Island Games and Commonwealth Games.

6. Funding

The County Committee will be responsible for all of its own funding. Sources for funding will come from the following:-

- a) The GBA General funds an annual allowance as agreed by the GBA Executive Committee from time to time. This will include a separate amount for administration. This sum is intended for each playing season but may be claimed from the GBA Treasurer anytime after the end of the previous season.
- b) The Guernsey Sports Commission. Appropriate claim forms must be submitted for all travel claims and allowances where possible.
- c) Other Guernsey Authorities including the Guernsey Island Games LBG and Guernsey Commonwealth Games Association as applicable.
- d) Badminton England and other relevant non-Guernsey organisations.
- e) Third party sponsors. But this must be obtained in liaison with the GBA Treasurer and President to avoid possible conflicts of interest.
- f) Self-fundraising activities in liaison with the GBA Executive Committee. This is to avoid conflicts of interest, and to ensure that funds are raised fairly for all aspects and areas of the GBA.
- g) Other areas agreed with the GBA Executive Committee.
