We aim to create an enjoyable environment for all young people who wish to take part in badminton at the Rohais Hall.

We accept that young people have the right to be safe, secure and free from threat and abuse.

Young people deserve to be treated with respect and for their concerns to be listened to and acted upon.

We will ensure that Junior members have specific activities set up for them with adequate supervision.

The Association will ensure that any badminton coach using the facilities is aware of and will apply the Badminton Association of England Code of Conduct for those working with children. This also applies to club members and other volunteers helping with children.
