BADMINTON ENGLAND REGULATION PENALTY SYSTEM

U19 EVENTS ONLY - The following are the penalties for each offence. All penalties must be paid within 28 days of their imposition.

(i)	Failure to arrive without notification	£100
(ii)	Failure to arrive with notification but without proper reason	£50
(iii)	Late arrival on court without proper reason	£20
(iv)	Failure to pay entrance fee can lead to a bar on entering other tournaments	
(v)	Cards for misconduct:	
	Yellow Card	£20
	Red Card	£40
	Black Card – matter will be referred to a disciplinary hearing	

ALL AGES – Yellow card – verbal warning and BE written record for season
Red card – written warning and BE written record for the season

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. No competitor shall be obliged to commence a match before 9am or after 8pm (U13), 9pm (U15), or 10pm (U17/19) on any day. Any competitor who is not prepared to play outside the times of play shall be entitled to a refund of the entry fee.
2. The period of knocking up before any match shall not exceed 3 minutes.
3. Entry fees will be £5.50 per player per event. Cheques payable to 'Guernsey Badminton Association'. Entry forms, together with appropriate fees, to be posted to Jane Le Tissier to arrive no later than Sunday 24th October 2010, or posted in the box at the Badminton Hall by the same date.
4. The first round will be on a 'Round Robin' basis with the number and size of each group being determined by the number of entries. Group winners will contest quarter/semi-finals (if 3 groups or more) and finals. Scoring will be the rally points system. No coaching is allowed once a match has commenced.
5. Players may only enter a maximum of SIX events in and/or above their own age group.
6. Perpetual Trophies will be presented to the winners of each event but will remain the property of the Guernsey Badminton Association and must be returned before the start of the next tournament.
7. All competitors resident outside Guernsey will be notified of the acceptance of their entries and of the time fixed for their first match. Guernsey competitors must ascertain their times of play from the order of play that will be pinned to the tournament notice board at the Badminton Hall. Any competitor not ready to play at the time stated will be liable to be scratched at the discretion of the Referee (for U19 events see the penalty that might apply as detailed on the back of this form). Competitors must not leave the hall while they are still in the competition without the prior permission of the Referee.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries without assigning any reason and to seed the draw. The Committee also reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in each event.
9. Coloured clothing will be allowed at the sole discretion of the Referee, but MUST BE acceptable badminton sports clothing. Advertising will not be permitted on clothing other than the normal manufacturers' logo. Track suits will be allowed during knocking up, but not during play.
10. The tournament will be run in accordance with Badminton England's Regulations for Tournaments.
11. Entry in the Tournament will imply the acceptance of the above conditions, and your availability to play as and when required.
12. Yonex feather shuttles will be used.
13. Players shall be eligible to play providing that they were born on or after 1st January 2000 (U11), 1st January 1998 (U13), 1st January 1996 (U15), 1st January 1994 (U17) or 1st January 1992 (U19).
